The call is open to researchers working on various aspects of modern Japan—defined as post-Meiji Restoration—in humanities (including, but not limited to literature, linguistics, history, translation theory, arts—including *manga* and *anime*—philosophy), women and gender studies, pop culture, minorities, etc.

Interested contributors should submit an abstract, keywords, short bio, and contributions not to exceed 8,000 characters, in English, following Chicago Manual of Style Author-Date (https://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide/citation-guide-2.html), no later than August 15, 2022. Review results and the papers selected for publication will be announced by November 30.

Book reviews on recent books (published in the past four years) on Japan not to exceed 1,200 characters are also invited. Reviews must be submitted in English, although the books reviewed can be in other languages as well.
